Intended audience	Include information about the audience and how the innovation met their needs.	10
Evidence of impact	Evidence might include pre-and post-surveys, evaluations, quotes, or other data.	20
Closing statement	Summary of the project including but not limited to lessons learned or next steps.	15
Included outside links	Only information on your slides will be reviewed.	-10

- how it was implemented.
- who benefited from this innovation.
- evidence of impact.
- transfer of learning to improve practice and impact student achievement.
